

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


People want to recognise themselves and society

... IN THE PANELS THEY LISTEN TO. THIS TRANSLATES IN THE DEMAND FOR MORE BALANCED PANELS, NOT ONLY IN TERMS OF GENDER BUT ALSO IN TERMS OF AGE AND ORIGIN. THEY WANT TO SEE THE WORLD IN WHICH THEY LIVE REFLECTED. A SOCIETY IS DIVERS AND THEREFORE PANELS SHOULD BE A FAMILIAR, RECOGNIZABLE REFLECTION OF IT.


Disliking gender exclusive panels

The majority of Belgians indicate that they prefer a panel composed only of men the least. Among women this disliking is more outspoken than among men. It doesn't represent our society and people want to recognise themselves and society in panels.



Representative for our society

Spontaneously Belgians indicate they want panels who represent our society. Mostly they expect diversity in terms of generation and gender, but also in terms of ethnicity. Among those with a multicultural background the need for more ethnicity within panels is more pronounced.




A mismatch between the current and the desired composition of panels

BELGIANS HAVE A CLEAR PREFERENCE FOR GENDER BALANCED PANELS. HOWEVER WHEN THEY ARE WATCHING PANELS ON TV OR LISTENING TO THEM AT PROFESSIONAL CONGRESSES OR WEBINARS, THEY MOSTLY SEE AN OVERREPRESENTATION OF MEN IN THOSE PANELS. WHILE SPEAKERS AND ORGANISERS ARE AIMING FOR GENDER BALANCED PANELS.


Desired panel composition

8 out of 10 Belgians prefer a gender balanced panel as a starting point for a representative image of our society. When 'pushed' even 9 out of 10 Belgians prefer a gender balanced panel.



Desired panel composition


In line with the gerenal expectations of a panel, 8 out of 10 wants to listen, speak or organise a gender balanced panel. Other perspectives lead to more interesting converstations.



Mismatch panel composition

While the majority of speakers and organisers think panels are gender balanced. Belgians who listen to panels on TV or during a congress, indicate they mostly hear a mainly male panel with a female participant. This is in contrast to the desired gender balanced panels.





Preference for gender balanced panels is both implicit and explicit

BOTH VIA IMPLICIT AND EXPLICIT METHODS BELGIANS ATTRIBUTE ALL SUGGESTED BENEFITS TO A GENDER BALANCED PANEL. MOREOVER A PANEL EXCLUSIVELY EXCITING OUT OF ONE OF THE BOTH GENDERS, IS ALWAYS SEEN AS UNREPRESENTATIVE.


Subconscious preference

Subconsciously Belgians attribute all associations positively with a gender balanced panel. While both the 100% male or female panel is strongly perceived as unrepresentative. Moreover the 'all-male' panel has overall more negative associations.



Explicit preference

Both consciously and subconsciously Belgians attribute all associations to a gender balanced panel. However, it is important to note that each panel member should have a contribution due to their qualifications.
